What is your Net worth?

We too as individuals must take stock periodically of our financial position, our net worth.

 We keep track annually, quarterly, monthly, daily or in real time depending on our technology.

Net worth is a metric used to track the wealth of these individuals.

- It helps us to understand our current financial position.
- It is the value of assets we own versus the liabilities we owe at any point in time.



HOW TO COMPUTE OUR NET WORTH

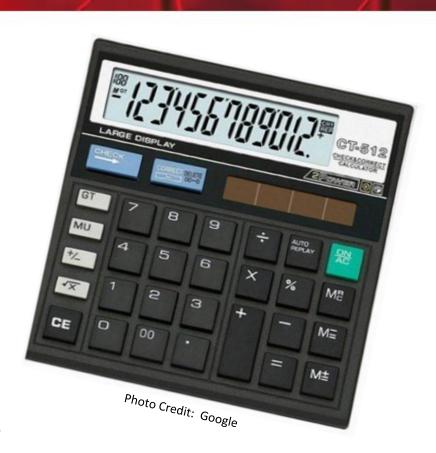
What is your Net worth?

Net Worth is one of the easiest things to compute:

The formula is

ASSETS - LIABILITIES = NET WORTH

- Positive net worth is when our assets are higher in value than our liabilities, while
- Negative net worth shows that our debts are higher than the things we own.





ASSET AND LIABILITIES -1

Assets

- Assets are things we own for which there is a reasonable market value.
- Any resource that we own and control that can be used to create economic value. They have the capacity to grow our wealth.
- It can be tangible like a car or intangible like a brand name.

ASSET AND LIABILITIES - 2

Liabilities

- A liability are financial obligations we owe to others e.g. a personal loan, credit card debt, travel loan, student loans etc.
- They represent obligations and financial commitments that need to be paid for by us, and consequently, they reduce the value of our asset.
- When we receive money in advance for services you have not offered, it is also a liability because you haven't earned it yet.

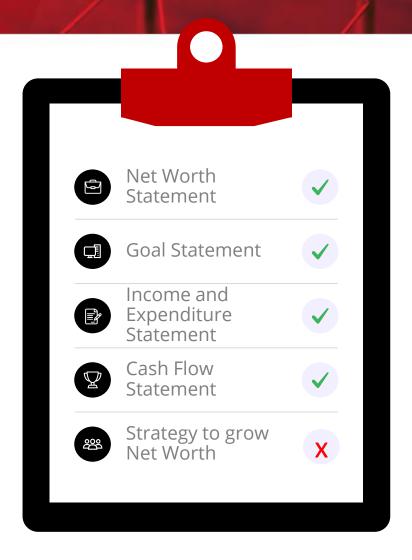


NET WORTH STATEMENT

What other things to consider

Once next step is to create the following statements:

- Goal Statement: a statement of where we want to go (SMART goals)
- Income and Expenditure Statement: What we earn and what we are spending.
- Cash flow Statement: from our income and expenditure statement we can derive our cash statement (how much cash we receive during a particular period

1: Change your Understanding of Time

1. CHANGE OUR UNDERSTANDING OF TIME

How We View Time

- Go to School,
- Graduate, get a job,
- Stay on the job until we lose it or retire.

Basically, we exchange our time for income.

- The downside of this model is that time is finite, we only have 24 hours in a day.
- Of that 24 hours most of our earning power is limited to 9 hours, 5 days in a week.
- 9 hours in a day is just about 38% of our allotted time in a day

1. CHANGE OUR UNDERSTANDING OF TIME

Mark Zuckerberg – Net Worth \$86.5 Billion

- Mark Zuckerberg, the founder of the social network site Facebook.
- Facebook's Average revenue per user is US 1 cent per minute.
- If we convert that to Naira at the current Naira -Dollar exchange rate, that is N3.90k they make per minute.
- Whether Zuckerberg, is sleeping, walking his dog or taking his daughter to outing, his company still makes N3.90k per minute.
- Currently, the average number of active users on Facebook each month is about 2.5 billion.

About Compound Interest

- Compound interest is one of the ways the rich grow their wealth.
- It is a great way of cultivating a lifestyle of less work by making money with money.
- Compound interest (or compounding interest) is interest calculated on the initial principal, which also includes all of the accumulated interest from previous periods on a deposit or loan.

In simple terms, it is interest we earn on interest.

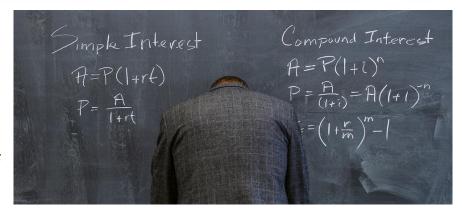

a little over ¥191 million



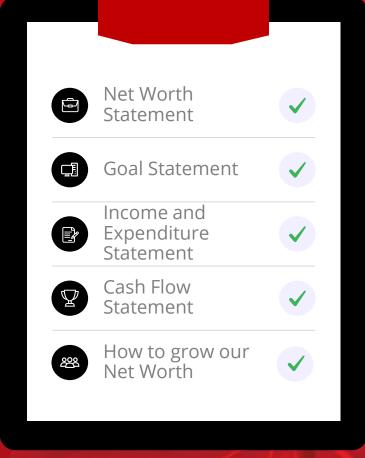
3. UNLEASH THE POWER OF COMPOUND INTEREST
