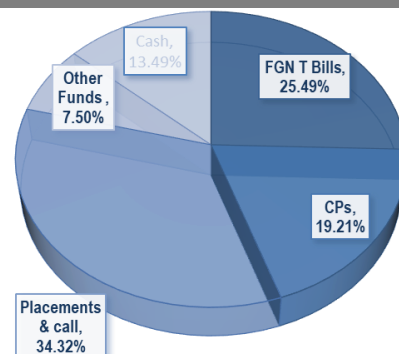
### Review and Outlook

- Buy-pressure increased in the Nigerian Treasury Bills secondary market in the month of October, as quoted prices on securities rose, thereby pulling yields lower. Average yield nosedived to 0.54%, down from 1.85% for the previous month.
- At the NTB Primary Market Auction (held on October 14, 2020), stop rates declined further to 1.0000%, 1.0000% and 2.0000% for the 91-Day, 182-Day and 364-Day bills respectively.
- Average valuation yield on Commercial Papers closed lower, closing at 4.56%, compared to 5.33% in September.
- Inflation rate for the month of September rose to 13.71%, up from 13.22% reported for the previous month. The market is currently spotting a negative real return of 13.37% on 90 Day NTB.

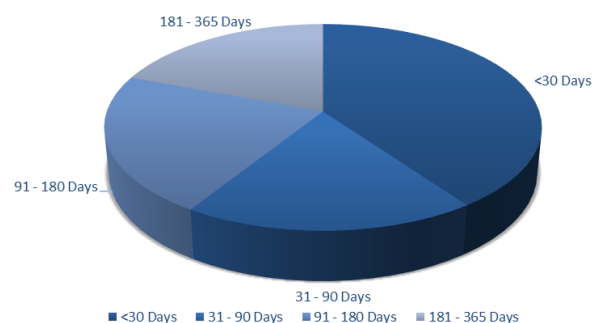

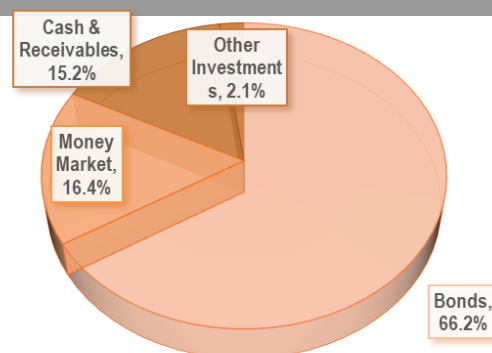
### Review and Outlook

- Increased buy-pressure in the Nigerian Treasury Bills secondary market raised quoted prices on securities. Average yield nosedived to 0.54%, down from 1.85% for the previous month. Stop rates at the last NTB Primary Market Auction (held on October 14, 2020) declined further to 1.0000%, 1.0000% and 2.0000% for the 91-Day, 182-Day and 364-Day bills respectively.
- Average yield in the Federal Government Bonds secondary market fell to 4.08%, down from 6.84% in the month of September, as rising system liquidity and investors' appetite for risk-free securities buoyed market demand.
- Current inflation rate stood at 13.71%, while average yield closed at 4.08%. This means a -9.63% average real return on Fixed Income Investments.

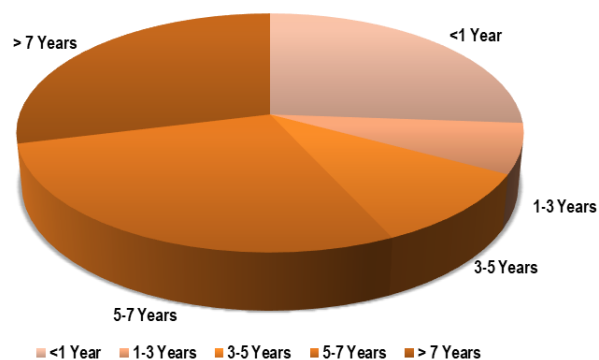

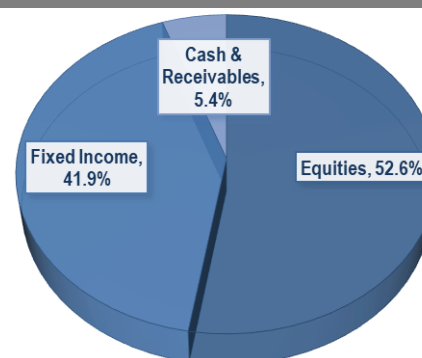

Gains in DANGCEM (+12.68%), BUACEMENT (+30.00%) and WAPCO (+22.22%) propped the Industrial Index, while MANSARD (+11.11) and AIICO (+19.44%) raised the Insurance Index. The Banking Index rose on the back of GUARANTY (+9.43%) and ZENITHBANK (+18.82%). Contrastingly, losses in ARDOVA (-30.11%) and OANDO (-31.08%) depressed the Oil & Gas Index, while the Consumer Goods Index was pulled lower by price depreciations in GUNINESS (-43.43%) and UNILEVER (-36.82%).

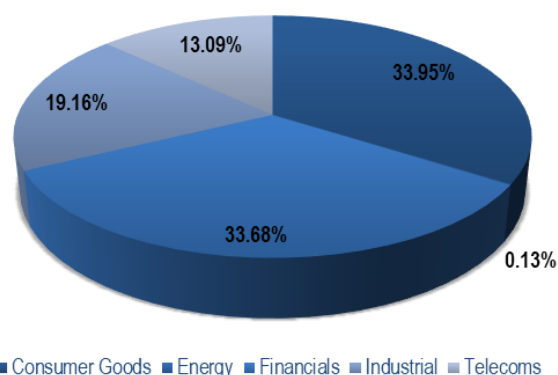

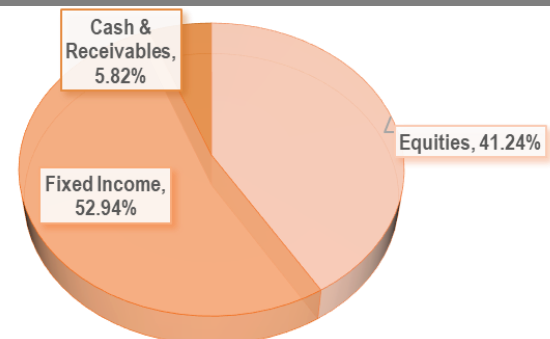

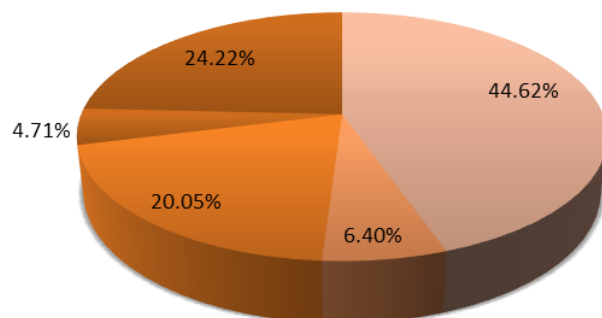
