
MARKET COMMENTARY


Bearish sentiments persisted in the Nigerian Treasury Bills secondary market in the month of February as yields on securities paced higher due to lower quoted prices on securities. Average yield surged by 688bps to 15.35% (from 8.47% in January). Yield on the 25 April 2024, 25 July 2024 and 23 May 2024 expanded by 887bps, 842bps and 807bps to 14.50% and 15.72% and 14.75% respectively.

Average NTB Primary Market Auction stop rate was 17.79%, compared to the previous month stop rate of 6.46%, as the stop rate for 91day, 182 day and 364 day closed at 17.00%, 17.50% and 18.00% respectively. A total of N1.27Tn was offered across all tenors, while N2.59Tn was allotted.

Nigeria's year on year inflation rate surged to 29.90% in the month of January 2024 compared tom 28.92% in December 2023, signaling a 98bps incrase. Month on Month, inflation rose from 2.29% in December 2023 to 2.64% in January 2024.

At the two-day inaugural meeting of the Moneytary Policy Committee of the Central Bank of Nigeria, the members voted to increase the benchmark interest rate by 400bps to 22.75%.









Average yield surged by 688bps to 15.35% (from 8.47% in January). Yield on the 25 April 2024, 25 July 2024 and 23 May 2024 expanded by 887bps, 842bps and 807bps to 14.50% and 15.72% and 14.75% respectively.

Average NTB Primary Market Auction stop rate was 17.79%, compared to the previous month stop rate of 6.46%, as the stop rate for 91day, 182 day and 364 day closed at 17.00%, 17.50% and 18.00% respectively. A total of \$\frac{1}{2}\$1.27Tn was offered across all tenors, while \$\frac{1}{2}\$2.59Tn was allotted.

MONTHLY FACTSHEET

FUND OBJECTIVE

The objective of the Fund is to grow investors' capital over the long term by maximizing total returns on portfolio equity holdings. It targets profitable businesses which are relatively underpriced.

MARKET COMMENTARY

The equity bourse was bearish in the second month of the year, as the All-Share index closed in the red, losing 1.16% Month on Month to 99,980.30 points from the 101,154.46 points close in January. Sectoral performance was mixed as three indices declined the market while two advanced. The Industrial Index (-13.69%) recorded the largest loss, followed by The Insurance Index (-6.08%) and The Banking Index (-2.01%). In Contrast, the Consumer Goods index (+16.45%) and The Oil & Gas Index (+4.14%) advanced with The Consumer goods reporting the highest gains.

During this month's auction, the DMO presented instruments valued at \$\mathbb{A}2.50\text{Tn}\$ to investors, offering new issuances of the 18.50% FGN FEB 2031 (Stop rate: 18.50%) and 19.00% FGN FEB 2034 (Stop rate: 19.00%) bonds. The subscription level settled at \$\mathbb{A}1.90\text{Tn}\$, indicating a bid-to-offer ratio of 0.8x (compared to 1.7x at last month's auction). Eventually, the DMO allocated instruments worth \$\mathbb{A}1.49\text{Tn}\$, resulting in a bid-to-cover ratio of 1.26x.


